

If the Panel is satisfied that the admission criteria have been properly applied and if your child achieved the pass mark of 111, the Panel will then consider whether it would be prejudicial to the efficient education or the efficient use of resources at Slough Grammar School if your child was admitted. This is effectively to look at whether the published admission number is a justified limit or whether any more pupils could be admitted.

**Stage Two** - If the Panel is satisfied that the published admission criteria have been properly applied and (if appropriate) that there would be prejudice to the school if your child was admitted, the Panel must then go on to the second stage where the Panel will listen to your case and balance the degree of prejudice to the school in admitting your child against the weight of the reasons you put forward for admission, before arriving at a final decision.

#### **THE COMMUNICATION OF THE DECISION**

The Clerk will inform you of the Appeal Panel's decision in writing as soon as possible after the Hearing. The school's Governing Body and representatives will also be advised. The decision of the Appeal Panel is final and binding.

#### **SUCCESSFUL APPEALS WHOSE SCORE WAS BELOW 111**

If your appeal is successful, you will be allocated a place at Slough Grammar School.
